Parkway Hospital in 2000 and returned to La Ceiba shortly thereafter to enjoy her retirement. Vilma returned to NY regularly to spend time with her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren.

As the matriarch of her family, Vilma (affectionately known as “Mima”) was a woman who exemplified faith, grace, servitude and strength. Whether she was cooking tortillas/food, shopping for others or reaching out on the phone; her servant's heart and hospitable nature, always ensured family and friends were cared for. 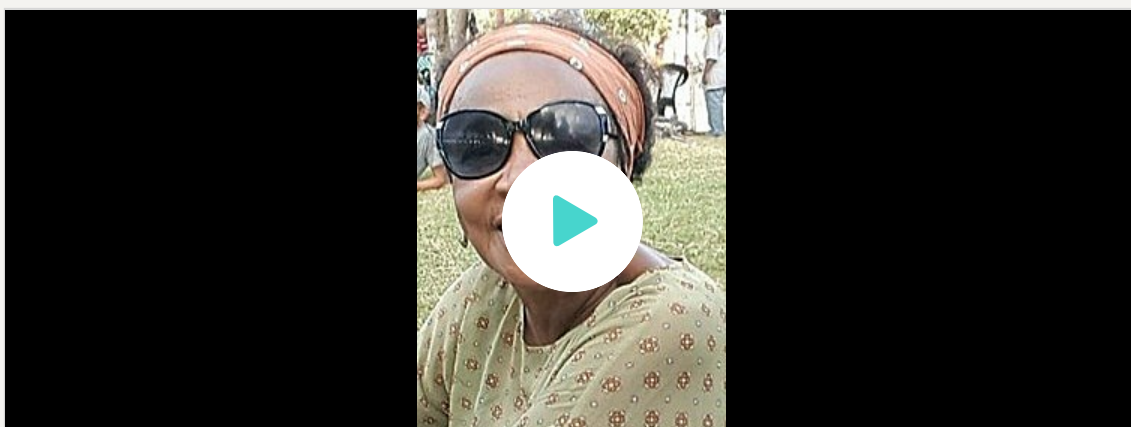
